Junior FAM Scouting Competition **Rules and Regulations**

Competition Definition:

- 1. The 1v1 Football Competition is a tournament that involves two players facing off against each other in a game of football.
- 2. The competition aims to showcase individual skills, technique, and decisionmaking abilities.
- 3. The Mini Football Field size if 30m X 20m.

Competition Format:

- 1. This is a 1 player versus 1 player solo/ individual competition.
- 2. You do not need a team to play in this competition
- 3. Each player will plays 3 rounds on each stage.
- 4. One Round = 3 minutes.
- 5. Winner advance to the next stage (the following week)
- 6. Loser will be eliminated and receive the Premium immediately
- 7. All players are highly recommended to wear shin guards and proper equipment for their protection.
- 8. The referee's word in all cases is final. The referees have been instructed to issue cards to any player who shows dissent.
- 9. If a player receives two yellow cards in a match this will result in a red card and the player will be automatically disqualified.

- 10. Any acts of intentional violence may result in the player being disqualified from the tournament based on the organizer's decision and referee's report and banned from any future tournament/ competition with Junior FAM.
- 11. All games are on a fixed schedule and you are expected to be ready for your scheduled game time.
- 12. To enter the field area, you must have your lnk stamp on hand.
- 13. In this case, the Referee reserves the right to default the infringing player, abandon the game, and submit a report to the Organizing Committee for a decision. If for any reason, a match could not be played, the match may be rescheduled at the discretion of the organizer.
- 14. In the case of any appeal or protest on any decision of the referee and any result, the player's parents/ representative/ guardian is required to submit a deposit of RM100 to the organizer's desk to begin the appeal investigation.

 If the investigation result favours the player, the organizer will return the deposit. If otherwise, the deposit will be forfeited.

PLAYER REGISTRATION

- 1. Registration Opens as early as 7:30 am in the morning.
- 2. Participants must register their attendance 30 minutes before their competition time for briefing and competition rules.
- 3. Cut-off Registration time for attendance registration will be 10 minutes before the competition time.
- 4. In the case of participants later than the Last Cut-Off registration time,

 Referees/ judges have full rights to disqualify the participants
- 5. All players must bring along their original Identification Card of valid passport or on all days of the competition for verification purposes.

- 6. If a player does not have his/her original passport or respective ID validation, then he/she will not be registered and will not be allowed to participate until they produce the original.
- 7. All players will receive a Stamp on their hand upon registration with their original identification.
- 8. Players are required to wear appropriate attire including boots and shin guards. Any player inappropriately dressed can be disqualified from playing.

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Girls Players can play one age group younger than their age. For example, if the girl player is 10 years old, she can play Under 8.
- 2. All players name and age should be submitted to the application link sent.

Tie Breakers:

- During the group stages, all matches that end will be decided on the 3rd rounds.
- 2. In the event of a tie in the standings, we will use the following measures to determine the winner: 1) Extra time of 1 minutes on the Round 3 Game, 2) Sudden Death Penalty Shoot-out or 3) Coin Toss. The measurement decision is taken by the in-charge referee or panel of judges.

Delays:

 Matches will continue as scheduled except for any unexpected events. The decision to postpone a match will be at the discretion of the tournament organizers.

Medal & Trophy

- After once stage ended, the disqualified players are required to collect their merchandise from the organizer's desk.
- 2. For players who advance to the next round, you are not required to collect your merchandise.

Medical & Liability:

 Organizers will not be held liable for any death, disability, personal injury, loss of property, or any other loss howsoever arising from any cause whatsoever at any time during this tournament.

Amendments:

1. The competition organizers reserve the right to modify or amend these rules and regulations as necessary, with proper notification to participants.

By participating in the Junior FAM Scouting Competition, all players agree to comply with the above rules and regulations.

Failure to adhere to these rules may result in penalties, disqualification, or expulsion from the competition, as determined by the organizers and the appointed referees.
